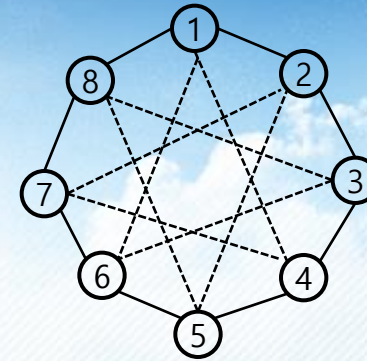
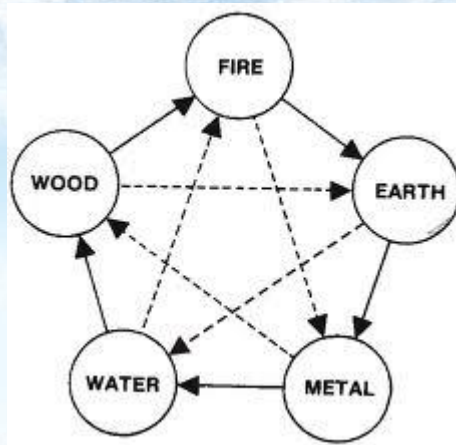

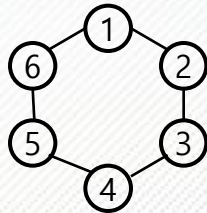
2.1.2. Red Sea(Fire,South), Black Sea (Water, North)



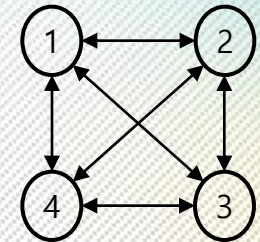
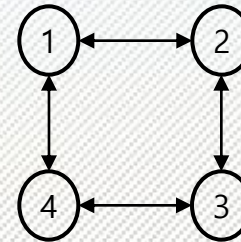
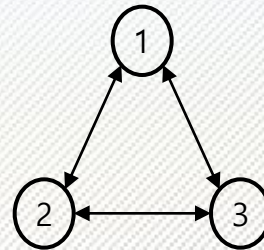
2.1.3 YinYangWuxing - Minimum system of MECE

(mutually exclusively and collectively exhaustively)

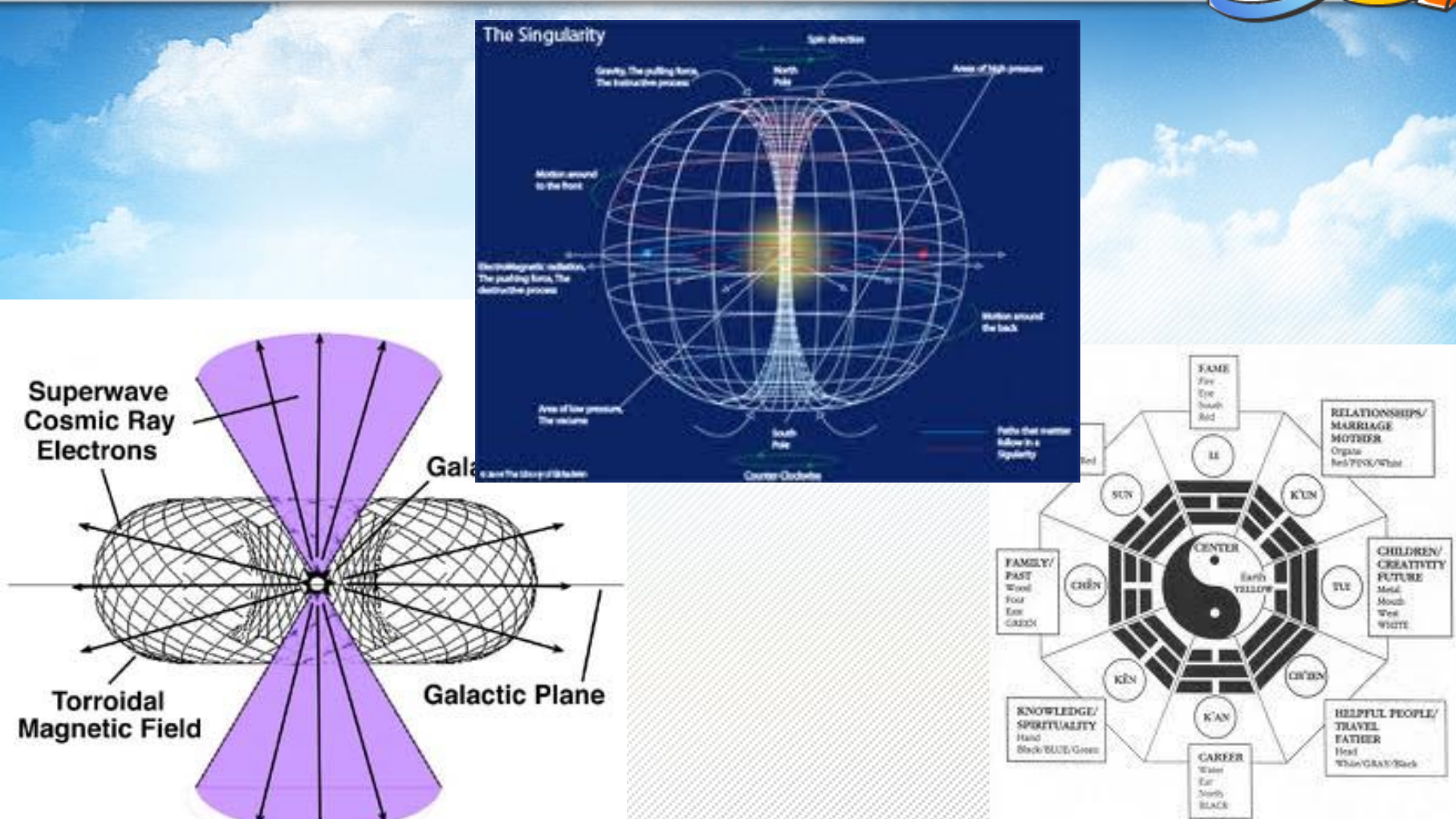


Six elements have two axis



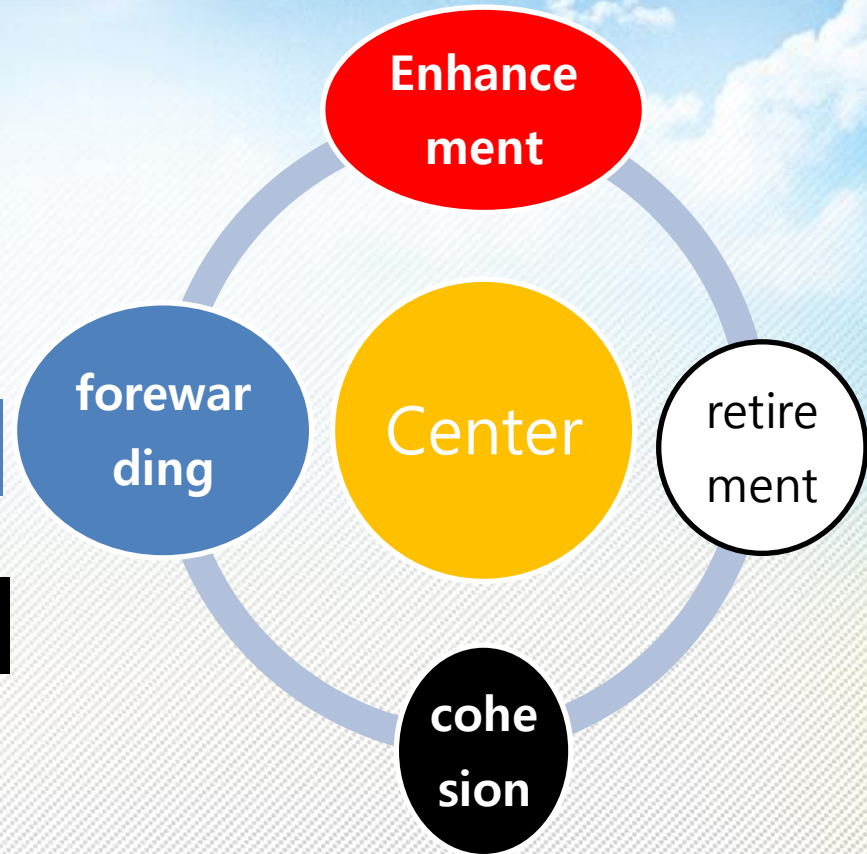
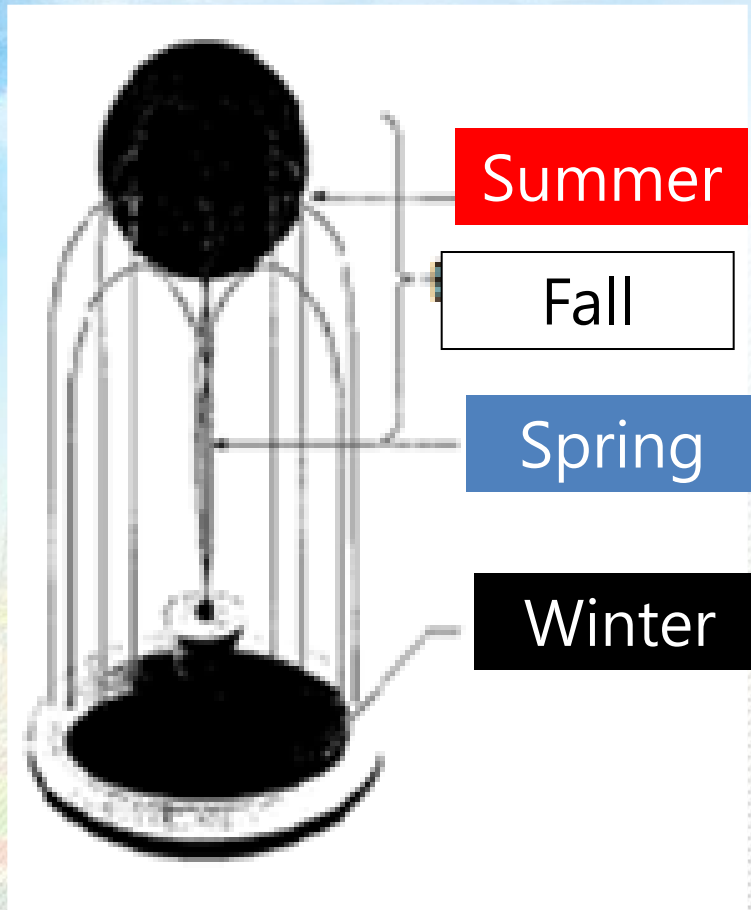
Four and three elements cannot

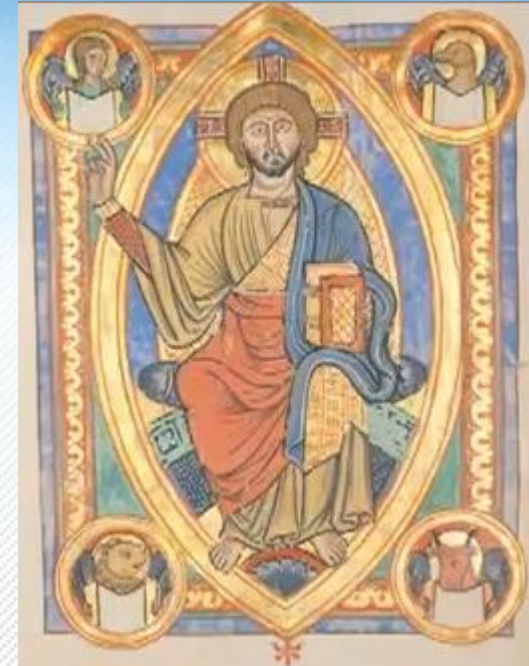

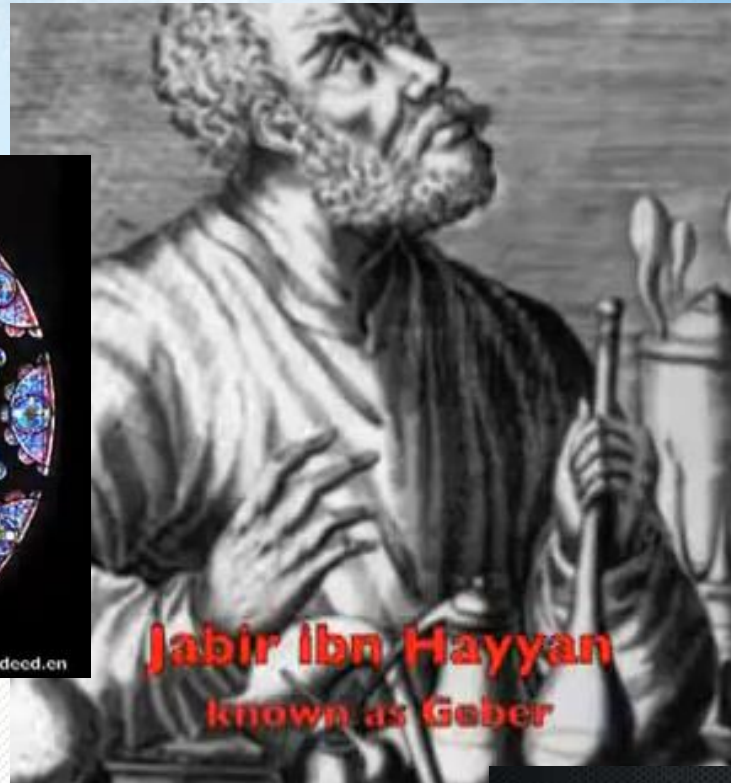
